Parents, pastors, and congregations may feel the lack of support, care, and resources to respond to its false claims and in turn appreciate and celebrate God's gift of identity in creation.

- Equip pastors, provide direction for congregations, encourage lay people, help educators/administrators, and educate parents to better understand identity and the liberating truth of our creation as male and female as revealed in Scripture.
- Offer creation-affirming care and support to parents with children who struggle with gender confusion, and clinical care to individuals and families who are affected by transgender ideology.
